[Big Yellow School Bus Grant](#) - supports transportation costs for arts experiences that offer significant education value.

[Out of School Grant](#) - supports quality arts education activities for underserved PK-12 students occurring outside of the normal school day. Activities (for example, theater productions or art classes) can be held at school or at a location beyond the campus. **This would be a great opportunity to bring in a guest conductor to your school or to a regional event.**

[School Touring Grant](#) - supports the cost of presenting and/or performing artists to PK-12 students. [School-Touring-Qualified performers](#) can present at school assemblies or classroom workshops.

[Peter R. Marsh Foundation Middle School Music Grant](#) - I've used this one to buy a tenor saxophone or other mid-priced student model instrument. Make sure you actually spend time in the nursing home with the residents!
