In September 2019, The California PBIS Coalition, recognized Rowland Elementary's successful PBIS implementation at the GOLD level. This award reflects excellence in the measurement of fidelity as well as our schools' efforts in implementing the core features of Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports.



What is PBIS?

Positive Behavior Interventions and Supports (PBIS) is a multi-tiered framework for creating and maintaining a positive school climate by teaching and acknowledging clear behavior expectations. Here at **Rowland Elementary**, our behavior expectations are **PRIDE**: **Problem Solving**, **Respect/Responsibility**, **Integrity**, **Determination and Empathy**.

PBIS Implementation Data

School-Wide PBIS Fidelity Score (Goal: 70% or higher) The Tiered Fidelity Inventory (TFI) measures the level of implementation of PBIS. Schools scoring at 70% or higher on the TFI are considered effective and more likely to see outcomes.

Our implementation data revealed that one of our strengths is **1.4 Teaching Expectations:** Expected academic & social behaviors are taught directly to all students in classrooms & across other campus settings/locations. One focus area for next year should be **2.10 Level of Use (Evaluation):** Team follows written a process to track the proportion of students participating in Tier II supports, and access is proportionate.
