Reconfirmation Meeting for April

Reconfirm instructional delivery method:

All students will attend classes in person five days a week, unless parents opt for the fully virtual option through Lincoln Learning.

Reconfirm how instruction will be delivered for each grade level:

Elementary (Grades K - 6): Face to face instruction, five days a week.

Middle School (Grades 7 - 8): Face to face instruction, five days a week.

High School (Grades 9 - 12): Face to face instruction, five days a week.

Reconfirm whether or not the district is offering higher levels of in-person instruction for English language learners, special education students, or other special populations:

All students will be in-person. All necessary special services will also be provided in person.
