



<u>Associate of Science Oregon Transfer Degree-Business</u>

About the Program: The statewide Associate of Science Oregon Transfer degree in Business is designed for students transferring to baccalaureate degree programs as business majors. Those completing the ASOT – Business degree are assured junior-level standing for registration purposes and will have met the lower-division general education requirements of any Oregon public university. Grade point average requirements for entry into the university's major are not necessarily satisfied by the ASOT – Business degree. Students should be aware that if they transfer before completing this degree, courses will be evaluated individually toward the general education requirements of the college of their choice. Entry Requirements: Students are required to complete the <u>Placement Process</u> to determine skill level and readiness in math, reading, and writing. As part of their training program, students must begin with the courses within their skill level as determined through the Placement Process. In addition, students may also be required to enroll in classes that would increase their employability and success.

Graduation Requirements: Students must complete a minimum of 90 term credits of lower division collegiate courses with a minimum grade of "C" or better.

Elective Requirements: Complete a sufficient number of college-level (numbered 100 and above) courses to meet the total degree requirement of at least 90 credits. Although a maximum of 12 career and technical course credits can be transferred to a four-year institution, a maximum of 6 career and technical credits may be used toward this degree. Note: WR115 Introduction to Expository Writing may be used as elective credit if taken summer term 2000 or after and completed with a letter grade of "C" or better. Some OUS business schools require **two terms of statistics and two terms of calculus** prior to being accepted into their programs. It is recommended that students contact the specific OUS business school or program early in the first year of their ASOT – Business program to be advised about additional requirements and procedures for admission to the school or program.

MINIMUM TOTAL PROGRAM CREDITS: 90

On the back is a list of courses offered at GPHS that meet the requirements for this degree. Classes offered as credit through RCC are College Now classes. If you are taking a class taught by your high school teacher, you have a two-step online process to sign up for your COLLEGE NOW class at RCC. COLLEGE NOW classes are free.

Step 1.) Obtain your RCC ID (If you do not already have an RCC ID account, go to http://www.roguecc.edu/Students/Start/highschool.asp.

Step 2.) Let your teacher at GPHS know you are interested in taking college credit for the class.

Requirements for the Associates of Science Oregon Transfer Degree and the classes offered at GPHS that meet that requirement vary from year to year. Check with your counselor to verify your options.
