

Dorothy B. Padula Memorial Fund Scholarship Application

The **Dorothy B. Padula Memorial Fund** is to support costs associated with travel and study, including tuition for USM students studying internationally. Awards typically range from \$200-\$1500. To be eligible for this scholarship, you must:

- Be currently enrolled as a graduate or undergraduate degree candidate at USM
- Be in good academic standing
- Have submitted a study away application with the Office of International Programs (if you are planning to earn credit overseas).

Please note that students will not normally be funded for the same experience, course or program for a second time.

The following items are required in addition to the application form:

- Copy of your transcript (unless already submitted to the Office of International Programs).
- Short 1,000 word personal statement describing your proposed activity and how it will enrich your academic life at USM.
- Recommendation from a faculty member who has taught you (unless already submitted to the Office of International Programs)
