U14s, please consider purchasing a General License from US Ski and Snowboard. Signing up gets you into the US Ski Team pipeline and helps support the sport and our region! Start here. Thank you

Entries are due on in the Zone4 portal by 11:59 p.m., PST, Tuesday, December 16. Late entries until 3:00 pm PST Thursday, December 18. Paper entries are not accepted. Late entries past Thursday will NOT be accepted.

Changes must be completed by Thursday at 3:00 PM. There are no refunds. Please submit all scratches to the Race Desk on Race morning.

ENTRY FEES

\$45 per day (for sanctioned races), \$10 late fee. Youth (\$25/\$35) and Citizen race entry (\$40/\$50) per race with signup on Zone4. There are no late entries. If any U10 and under youth want to race untimed, they can show up at the start line 15 minutes before the start and do an untimed stadium or 1k race on either day.

The <u>ASC waiver</u> must be completed for each skier, volunteer, and racer. If the person is a minor, a parent or legal guardian must fill it out.

TRAIL ACCESS

ASC Trails are open on December 19, 2025, for training from 2-4:30pm. Both courses will be marked and open. All athletes and coaches need to be registered and need to fill out an ASC waiver before skiing. Everyone needs a valid ASC trail pass to ski.

WAXING AND FACILITIES

All waxing must be done outdoors. We will have an area to the west side of the parking lot, unless the weather is bad, and we will find an alternative location. Only those competitors and coaches preparing for the next scheduled race are allowed in the waxing area. Competitors must observe the US Ski and Snowboard NO FLUORO rule. ONLY non-fluorinated glide and kick waxes are allowed. Skis that have been waxed with fluorinated products should be cleaned following USSS guidance found here. Athletes can use the downstairs long room in the ASC Training Center. The green building is closed to racers.

Far West teams have agreed to a glide wax call for the weekend. This allows all of our coaches to focus more on athlete support and ensure a great racing experience!

There is a FIS rule: there is no waxing and no exchange of competition skis during the sprint heats, we will be following that rule and holding all skis during the sprints.


