

LRCA Spring Tournament

Tournament Date: May 1st- 3rd

In the event of dangerous weather or river/lake conditions, teams may withdraw and receive a full refund prior to deadline. The Catfish Association may postpone or cancel the tournament and refund entry fees prior to the start of the tournament. In the event the club postpones or cancels, only the Team Captain will be notified. The Team Captain is responsible for notifying their team members.

Team Size (Kids under 12 count as half a person)	2 or 3 People
Fishing Times: Friday at 3 PM until Sunday at 4 PM	
Weigh in Time: You can weigh in 5 Yellow Cat on Saturday and 5 on Sunday between 3 PM and 4 PM. You WILL be disqualified if not in line by the deadline.	
Tournament Size Minimums:	Channelcat: 12 ½ inches Yellowcat: 18 ½ inches Bluecat: 12 ½ inches Rough Fish: No minimum
General Rules: CAN ONLY FISH BELOW BELTON AND STILLHOUSE DAMS WITHIN THE LEON, LAMPASAS, AND LITTLE RIVER. (ORIGINAL LRCA RULES) 1. All participants must sign up prior to the deadline. 2. All fish must be fresh for weigh-in; the weigh-in official has final judgment. 3. State size and possession limits must be honored. Any team with fish that doesn't meet state minimum and possession limits will be disqualified from the tournament. (Please note that while the new state rules have no minimum size for channel and blue catfish, we still enforce our minimum. You can legally keep smaller fish, but cannot weigh them in.) 4. Each team can have no more than 100 hooks in the water at a time. (This includes, but isn't limited to, jug lines, throw lines, trot lines, and rod and reels) 5. Each team is limited to using a single boat at a time. 6. All participants must have a fishing license or exemption. 7. All teams will carry off their own guts if cleaning the fish at the weigh-in. 8. Only Yellow Cat counts for total weight, but you can enter jackpots for all other categories.
