

CHAMPFLEUR NOBILITY

A family that comes from a long line of judges and lawyers, and who holds the title of Magistre. Like those with similar peerage, this household is relatively "young" compared to the old noble blood of the Vidame nobility, having been in power for about nine generations. The former head, Geoffrey Claude Champfleur, was regarded to be the one who nurtured Champfleur's domain to its peak.

Yves Anatole Champfleur (Current Magistrate), 269
Class: Wizard (Force will, Water/Earth) - Oathbound

Virsche and Lloyd's uncle, former lawyer and the Magistrate of Aramore. A far cry from his predecessor, Yves is outwardly jovial and easy going, maybe a little shameless by nobility standards. At times he may even come across as dense, or maybe he just refuses to read the room. The eldest son he may have been, as well as the natural first heir, even before he took over his current position, there were whispers that he was not suited to be Magistrate, especially with his temperament. A lack in leadership skills as well as discipline was painfully obvious, to the point he was often compared to his younger brother. Since inheriting the title, these talks were mostly put to rest (whether it was because he had proven them wrong, or people saw there was no point comparing him to someone dead is anyone's guess) that was until Lloyd started handling more of the family's outer affairs.

Yves is a fervent believer of Aurea, but holds some distrust towards Triss. At the end of the day though, he's but a simple lamb and will do as he's ordered if it's Her will. Rumors

about his possible infertility have been a topic in gossip for years, seeing as he has yet to produce an heir.

Helena Champfleur née Estelle (Templar Master), 271 Class: Sage - Oathbound, (Ascended)

The fourth daughter from Vidame nobility, a Templar Master and the wife of Yves who for the most part keeps to herself. One might even consider her a ghost, as she's rarely seen outside of important family gatherings or social events. Misunderstood as a cold individual, when in reality she's just naturally introverted. Not particularly close with the remaining Champfleur kin nor pretends to be anything like a maternal figure despite being wards of Yves, but has a soft spot for them. Besides what is required of her as wife of the Magistrate, she does not involve herself too much with the estate's affairs- especially since she's preoccupied with her knightly duties.

A naturally devote, and is at odds with her husband whether to place fate in the current Oracle. Rumors about her possible infertility have been a topic in gossip for years, seeing as she has yet to produce an heir, she personally feels the scrutiny more than her husband especially because of her family's obvious disappointment.

Oswald Etienne Champfleur (Judge, deceased at 182) Class: Champion

The pragmatic second born that, if it were not for the succession structure, would have been the preferred heir of the Champfleur estate- or so the whispers go. He's someone who is firm in his beliefs and is savvy with his dealings. Between the two brothers, Oswald resembled their father the most in terms of discipline and work ethic. It is a shame then, that he had no desire to become entangled with the nuances of nobility- Instead pursuing law, the roots of their household's lineage. For all his sternness, however, a softer side exists only for his family. He would do anything in his power to protect them, even if it meant keeping secrets- because of this despite how close their bonds were, Virsche and Lloyd thought of their father as an enigma.

Eventually married Jeniva, although sometimes he can't help but feel he was tricked into doing so... no one outside the family dares to laugh at the ridiculous turn of events lest they face his wrath.

Jeniva Champfleur née Abertine (Designer, deceased at 177) Class: Enchanter (Hallucination, Projection)

Her lineage has long since fallen from their former status as nobles, and are now established traders from old money. Because she was raised in an environment that afforded more freedom than those of her ancestors, she ended up becoming a rambunctious and strong-willed woman. One who embraces challenges and has a witty disposition in life, although she has a mischievous streak when an opportunity to tease others presents itself. May have been the subject of rumors because of this; one thing people can agree on is one would either hate her or like her. Despite the gossip she finds herself involved in, she had made a name for herself as a reputable designer for nobles.

Through her earlier endeavors to establish her business she crossed paths with Oswald, and the (in)famous story of how she eventually started pursuing aggressively, much to his chagrin, was born. Growing frustrated at his lack of effort to fall for her, she had the brilliant idea to pull away after years of hinting he should court her (spoiler: she was the one who was courting him.) in hopes that he'll realize how she's weaseled her way to his heart. Needless to say it worked. There were rumors she was with child when she met her untimely death.

Virsche doesn't remember much about her, but she does know that she reminded her of the sun.

<u>Lloyd Frances Champfleur (Heir)</u>, 161
Class: Marauder (Marauder's Eye) - Oathbound

The finance officer of Aramore's affairs, as well as the forerunner to inherit the title 'Magistrate' from his uncle. Someone who has potential, but is lacking motivation, he had no desire to ever inherit a noble title- especially after his father's own wariness and disinterest towards nobles. It may have been the strong sense of responsibility that pushed him to at least help his household after noticing the decline of order in the estate. After all, he loved his family and held the legacy his grandfather left them in the highest regard. It was shortly after Virsche's return from Estraude that he was formally announced as the successor of Aramore, after finally accepting his uncle's offer.

Is overly protective of his younger sister and is primarily the reason he agreed to be heir, regardless of his late father's warning. Distrusts Triss and believes she has her own agenda. He generally dislikes how his people are so dependent on their faith, but dares not say anything in the public. Is currently being pressured to find a suitable marriage partner, much to his annoyance.

Virsche Lyra Champfleur, 115
Class: Sage (Dissection, Stasis)

A young governess for the Belrose family, as well as a research assistant. Ever since the tragedy of her family, she was for the most part unavailable to the general public; She was persistently shielded from any outside eyes, with the sole exception being close friends. It was only after her return from Estraude did she start attending social events, although still few and far in between.

Had initially been training to become a Templar Knight, but after having amnesia and as well as experiencing a world outside of Delverne, she questions if they really are following the right path. As of Triss' arrival and the announcement of her brother as successor to their house, Yves has been persuading her to quit her job.

Claude Xavier Champfleur (deceased, Former Magistrate) Class: Exorcist

The former head of the Champfleur household that brought it to new heights, marking his generation to be the most prosperous for their domain. He is eternally remembered for his sternness and uncompromising attitude. There was hearsay that he had been in meetings with the Sovereign during his time, negotiating something, people aren't sure what it was about however. His impact is still held as the standard for Aramore, so it's current successors are heavily scrutinized by the public.

Was greatly respected and idolized by Lloyd.

Éloise Agatha Champfleur née Theriault, 392 Class: Wizard (Fire/Wind)

The former matriarch of the Champfleur estate, due to her old age she is living away in the countryside of Delverne. Known as a fountain of knowledge and an economics expert, she helped support her husband's endeavors to make the family name prosper. Despite her frail state and her soft disposition, her mind is still sharp; she keeps up to date with the current climate of Delvan court and general news. For a time she had guided her eldest when he had assumed his role, but struggled often to make him see reason. Was very much against Virsche leaving for Estraude, and her health had turned for the worse after she left.

ABERTINE HOUSEHOLD (HUGE WIP)

Former Vidame nobility that eventually fell out of power a few generations ago, they are now established businessmen and traders. Some within still covet the peerage and privileges their lineage once had, and a number of members are married to noble families. Basically they come from old money lol

Virsche and Lloyd's maternal aunt, she is currently a council member in her families' business. A no nonsense sort of woman, whose pride can make her a difficult person to navigate around, Nadine is determined- if not somewhat bullheaded. A trait she shared with her younger sister, Jeniva, although her willfulness is related to her desire to return their family name back to its glory days. Initially she had devices for her sister to marry Oswald, but these plans fell apart when Jeniva pursued the younger Champfleur instead.

Dominique Eury Christler, 183
Class: Sage

Virsche and Lloyd's cousin and Nadine's eldest son, he has made a name for himself as a well known jewelry artisan. The more energetic of Nadine's children, as well as an obvious eccentric. Only cares about Delvan politics because most of his commissioners are nobles, but other than that he's more focused on his Art. Lloyd personally finds him a nuisance; in his words "just watching him leaves me exhausted"

Michel Beau Christler, 139
Class: Shaman

Nadine's youngest child, and studying to further his skills as a healer. Currently he does volunteer work in local clinics. He's a young man with a pleasant smile but is known to have a sharp tongue and a penchant for getting under people's skin. Despite his rotten attitude, he takes his work very seriously. Acts as his mother's eyes and ears- often delegated to collect information since he gets around the community. During Virsche's recovery, he was one of the few healers that were allowed to examine her.

Solon Aero Abertine, 163 Class: Knight (Oathbound)

The middle child of the Christler family, although Solon took on the 'Abertine' name instead and lived with their grandparents once they became of age at the orders of their mother. Something they were more than willing to do considering how suffocating it was to be in the same house as her. For a time they lived in Miras as a scholar, before they eventually had to return to Delverne following the recent conflict. Is a bit of a mystery to both Virsche and Lloyd, since they didn't often go to family gatherings, but out of all of Nadine's children- Solon was the easiest to spend time with. Virsche feels the most comfortable sharing her time in Estraude with them.
