

VILLAGE OF CRESTON

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-30

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTON, WAYNE AND MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE VILLAGE OF BURBANK, OHIO FOR POLICE SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the Village of Creston has contracted with the Village of Burbank, Ohio to provide police services on an annual basis and;

WHEREAS, the Council deems it advisable to continue contracting to provide police services; and

WHEREAS, Council has reviewed the contract which is attached hereto and incorporates the same by reference finds that it is suitable and appropriate for the Village.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF CRESTON, WAYNE AND MEDINA COUNTY, OHIO THAT:

1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the Village of Burbank, Ohio for police services in accordance with the terms set forth in the contract attached hereto and made a part hereof and marked Exhibit "A". The effective date of the contract is January 1, 2025.
2. That it is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were taken in conformance with applicable open meetings laws and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in compliance with all legal requirements including any applicable open meeting requirements.
3. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the Village of Creston and its inhabitants; the specific reason for the emergency is to continuing providing police service uninterrupted to the Village of Burbank. Therefore this Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
