- Morphite
 - Flagged: +1.5sig
 - Though in decline for the last ~month, expect prices to rise. Looks to have bottomed out
- Megacyte
 - Flagged: +1.5sig
 - Should continue decline (though slowly). Expect oversupply from null/wh miners to continue

Outlier Analysis:

Corax:

- Flagged: -1.5sigma
- Volumes depressed, but price outlay positive in the short term

Shield Boost Amplifier II:

- Flagged: +2.0sig
- Massive buy-up this week. Prices are unstable (and lowering)

Upgraded Co-Processor

- ~~Flagged: +2.0sig~~
- ~~Module tiericide speculation. Action is probably over by now, but could trend up after Phoebe~~

Imperial Navy Acolyte

- Flagged: +1.5sig
- Price seems slightly depressed and should climb in the short term

Small Anti-EM Screen Reinforcer II

- Flagged: +1.5sig
- Growth in volume over the last ~month. Should drive prices up

Tengu Offensive - Magnetic Infusion Basin

- Flagged: +1.5sig
- Prices are up significantly and are expected to continue growing
 - NOTE: expect cost of production to fall due to industry changes and WH exploration event. Probably a bubble
 - NOTE: also, who uses rail/blaster tengus?

Inferno Fury Light Missile

- Flagged: +1.5sig
- Spiked due to buy-out and falling hard. Should be back to normal level this weekend

Hawk

- Flagged: +1.5sig
- Sales volume growing all fall. Expect production margins to improve (even if price falls)

Small Capacitor Booster II

- Flagged: +1.5sig
- Spiked, but overadjusted. Expect another price spike soon TM

Capacitor Flux Coil II

- Flagged +1.5sig
- Suddenly popular, expect more price growth. May be worth investing in

Small/Medium Transverse Bulkhead I

- Flagged + 2.5sig
- Hull tanking unironically popular as “derp ship” meta. Prices may rise as general login activity grows
- Probably worth producing, not worth trading
