- Important Notes: If you would like to make your own yule log, you will need a 17 X 12 inch baking sheet, parchment paper and the following ingredients:

Chocolate Cake

- 2 tablespoons melted butter
- ½ cup unsweetened cocoa powder
- ½ teaspoon kosher salt
- 2 tablespoons all-purpose flour
- 5 large eggs, at room temperature
- ⅔ cup white sugar
- ½ teaspoon vanilla

Chocolate Mascarpone Cream Filling

- 1 ⅔ cups powdered sugar
- ½ cup butter, at room temperature
- 1 ½ tablespoons unsweetened cocoa powder
- 1 pinch salt
- ⅓ cup mascarpone cheese

Whipped Chocolate Ganache topping

- 1 cup semi-sweet chocolate chips
- 1 cup heavy whipping cream

Mask Requirements and Social Distancing:
