    - 2. Float building started on September 26th and ends on October 5th. Check with your class officers for specific times and locations. Class officers - be sure to get the word out to your classmates! Lots of people need to help to make a good float!
    - 3. The start of Spirit Week is next week on Monday, October 3rd and lasts until Friday, October 7th. Our Spirit Week days are below:

Make sure to spread the word and earn spirit points for your grade! Spirit points will be counted in your advisory periods.

4. **ATTENTION ALL STUDENTS WITHOUT AN ADVISORY:** If your first class of the day is 3rd hour, you **MUST** tell security what grade you are in to be counted for spirit week participation when you walk in. Ex: “Hi I’m a Junior and I’m dressed for spirit week.” Make sure to spread the word so everyone can be counted!
5. Class officers should’ve received [Permission slips](#) for Crab Soccer and Tug-O-War. Permission slips are due to class sponsors/class officers by Monday, October 3rd. If you would like to participate, see a class officer! Make sure they pick up their bracelet from your class sponsor!
6. Crab soccer players are being released onto the football field at 2:20PM on Thursday, October 6th.
7. Class officers need to make the banners for the October 7th Pep Assembly. Each grade needs one horizontal sign. **SENIORS** need two vertical ones for the sides, one horizontal sign for the top, one horizontal for the fence on the football field, and one to run through when entering the football field. You should have the banners already- they were given to one of your class officers last week. Give Mrs. Ray your banner by Thursday so she can hang it up on Friday.
8. Panoramic photo- Seniors will be released to the gym to take their panoramic photo at 12:30 on October 7th. **No backpacks are allowed in the gym- please put them in your lockers!**
9. This year’s Homecoming Dance is on Saturday, October 8th from 7-10 PM.
  - Tickets will be sold online through GoFan.
  - Only 550 students will be allowed - buy your tickets early! The link is here <https://gofan.co/app/events/652965?schoolId=MI9927> and opened earlier this week on September 26th. You **NEED** to make an account through GoFan with your school email address. Your student ID will go in the promo code spot. Only one ticket per student. Buying for a friend? You will need to complete that in a separate transaction with their student ID.
  - We are allowing guest passes for this year’s dance. Middle school students or those over the age of 20 are not allowed to attend. Students who wish to take a guest from another school must turn in a completed guest pass application to Mrs. Ray **PRIOR** to purchasing their ticket. After turning in the guest pass application, you will receive a guest pass code to place in the promo code spot in order to purchase your ticket. Guest pass applications can be found in the main office. The last day to turn in a guest pass is October 5th. Make sure to turn it in on time!
  - Guest pass rules:
    1. Only one guest pass per CHS student
    2. Be accompanied by the CHS student that sponsored the application.

3. Show a current PHOTO ID (This can be a school ID or driver's license)
4. Have a *pre-purchased ticket*. NO tickets will be sold at the door and there is a set limit of 550 tickets. BUY YOUR TICKETS EARLY!
5. **CLASS OFFICERS:** You need to be at dance decorating on October 8 from 9AM- 1PM. You also need to be at cleanup for about 30-45 minutes after the dance ends. This is MANDATORY. Bring as many people as you can- the more people the easier it is to decorate! If you are a class officer you cannot make it to either decorating OR cleanup, you MUST find a replacement and tell one of the congress officers your name, your replacement, and whether they're for decorating, cleanup, or both
