Students are to have

- minimal absences
- positive citizenship
- participate in community service (25 hours per year)
- maintain a 2.0 GPA or higher in all classes
- membership in HOSA Future Health Professionals

9th grade - students are placed in College & Career Seminar and pre-academy core courses. Health will need to be taken in summer school or Extended Summer School.

10-12th grade - students are enrolled in four HCA classes each year unless taking agriculture, Honors, or AP.

<u>12th grade</u> - students take Human Anatomy and Physiology. As an articulated class with Modesto Junior College, students will be awarded BOTH high school and MJC credit. A grade of C or better must be earned. (College credits <u>will not</u> be listed on the high school transcript.)

** PE credits may be earned through sports in 10-12 grade if the PE Fitness Test is passed in 9th grade. (Two sports must be played in 10th grade in order to not take PE.)

The 4-year plan includes both TDHS graduation and 4-year college admissions requirements. Students may need to take an extra period (0) or take a Modesto Junior College course, while in high school, in order to complete all requirements for 4-year college admissions.

- 2 years of Foreign Language (3 years recommended) and 1 year of Visual or Performing Art (VPA) <u>MUST</u> be taken if a student plans on applying to a 4-year college immediately after high school.
- 3 years of math needed for graduation, 4 years recommended for college
- Dance will count as a VPA for college admissions if taken in PE
