Self Guided Instructions for Families

- 1. Start up your computer
- 2. Log into the venue's wireless network
- 3. Launch Internet Explorer from the desktop (NOT the app version on the Windows 8 Start screen)
- 4. Go to Chrome.com, download and install the Chrome browser
- 5. Launch Chrome and login with the student's school email address and password
- 6. Verify your school email works by clicking on the Apps icon () at the top of the screen, then clicking on the Gmail App.
- 7. Use the Apps Icon to access Google Drive
- 8. Go to eAchieve.com and click Login
- 9. Enter your Student Username and Password (same password as school email account)
- 10. If you are a high school or middle school student...
 - Find and click on the Student Resource Center in the My Classes area (note: the rest of your classes will show up here on the first day of school)
- 11. If you are an elementary school student....
 - Find and click on the eAchieve Elementary class in the My Classes area
- 12. Click on Live eSessions
- 13. Click on the "Summer Orientation Demo Link" (high & middle school) or the link for your class level if you are an elementary student
- 14. Click on Join Room
 - NOTE: you will be asked to download and install the Collaborate Launcher; follow the onscreen instructions to do so; it will take a few minutes; this is a one time operation
- 15. After the Launcher is installed, go back and click on the Join Room button again.
 - If the .collab file downloads but doesn't launch, you may need to double click on it.
 - o Again, this may take a few minutes to launch the first time. This is normal.
 - If it opens, you are good to go.
- 16. If you are not able to join the eSession, go to Java.com & download & install Java caution them to not have any "extras" checked to install with it
- Ask one of the staff for the MAPs Lockdown Browser install flash drive (or get it from http://tiny.cc/MAPlockdown) and install it.
- 2. NOTE: We are not recommending students update to Windows 10 yet as there are still many bugs.
