CWPA 2023 - 2024 Committee Charges

Best Book Award Committee

Charges:

- → Update call and criteria for selection as needed and informed by changes in scholarship
- → Solicit nominees for the annual CWPA Best Book Award
- → Seek diverse nominations in topics and/or authors' positionality
- → Reach out to authors whose work would fit the diversity requirements for nominations
- → Select a recipient for the award from among the nominees

Graduate Research Award Committee

Charges

- → Update call and criteria for selection as needed and informed by changes in scholarship
- → Solicit nominees for the annual CWPA Graduate Research Awards
- → Seek diverse nominations in topics and/or authors' positionality
- → Select recipients for the awards from among the nominees
- → Provide all submission authors with detailed written feedback on their manuscripts

Grants Committee

Charges

- → Create and launch a call for research and administration grants
- → Create a rubric for evaluating applications for each grant category
- → Determine the number of awards in each category
- → Select award winners for each grant category

Kenneth Bruffee Award Committee

Charges:

- → Update call and criteria for selection as needed and informed by changes in scholarship
- → Solicit nominees for the annual CWPA Kenneth Bruffee Award, the award for the best article published in WPA: Writing Program Administration
- → Unless such work was not published in the journal in the prior year, prioritize articles on diversity topics
- → Select a recipient for the award from among the nominees

Mentoring Committee

Charges

- → Establish a mentoring database with all willing mentors
- → Establish a more structured approach to mentoring (similar to the Coalition's)
- → Focus on mid- and late-career WPAs' mentoring needs (career shifts from WPA work to other administrative roles)

Nominating Committee

Charges

- → Solicit nominees for vacant Executive Board and Vice President positions
- → Determine a slate of candidates from the nominations for the CWPA election in the spring
- → Write a description of the process for soliciting and selecting candidates for the election

Outstanding Scholarship Award Committee

Charges

- → Update call and criteria for selection as needed and informed by changes in scholarship
- → Solicit nominees for the annual CWPA Outstanding Scholarship Award, an award for outstanding article length scholarship published outside of the *WPA journal*
- → Prioritize articles on diversity topics
- → Select a recipient for the award from among the nominees

Recruitment Committee

Charges:

- → Increase membership in new and underserved populations within the organization
- → Produce PR promotion materials for targeted audiences
- → Connect to individual formal and informal WPAs at all types of institutions
- → Connect to regional or national organizations for specific groups of WPAs: HBCU Consortium, TYCA regionals, SLACs, ...
- → Briefly survey those individuals for 1) their expectations from CWPA, 2) reasons they do not join
