I could not manage to fund his studies in Myanmar as I could not earn enough to both feed him and pay for his schooling. It was only possible to provide him food once or twice a day and the food was given to me as a part of my daily wages and earnings from being a maid.

As a student, my son is regular and attentive in his studies. He wants to be a teacher. Because of this, I would like to thank the Rohingya Children's Project (RCP) for their hard work and providing a great educational facility for Rohingya children. I hope our children can meet their goals and dreams if these schools continue. I would like to invite RCP to continue to support us in the future.
