**COURSE DESCRIPTION**

This is a specialization course in the Government and Public Administration career cluster. This fourth-year course builds on the general information covered in Naval Science I, II, and III and develops leadership skills through working as command and staff leaders. Additional communication skills are developed, including methods of instruction, preparation, and proper conduct of cadet-led classes. Human relations, group dynamics, orienteering, contemporary United States issues, and advanced military history studies are also included.

This course counts as an elective credit.

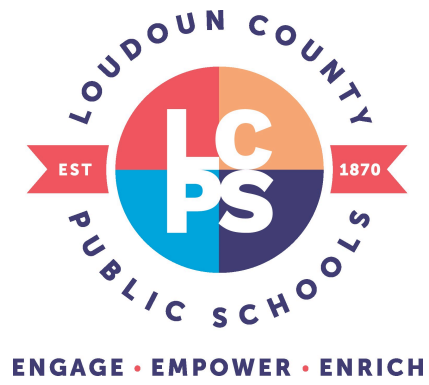
