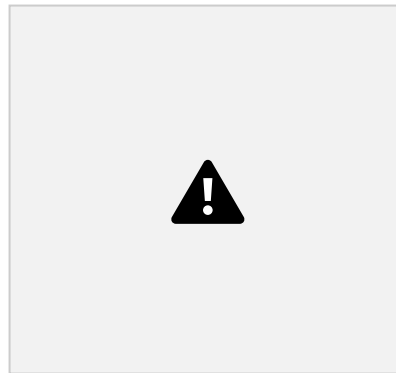


Dialysis 101

experience dialysis up to 3x a week MWF



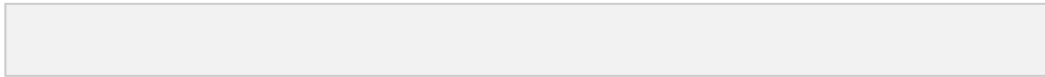

All excess materials will be donated to either the fashion department or the Textile Center to reduce waste. We are also working within our inventory to maximize product and improve quality.

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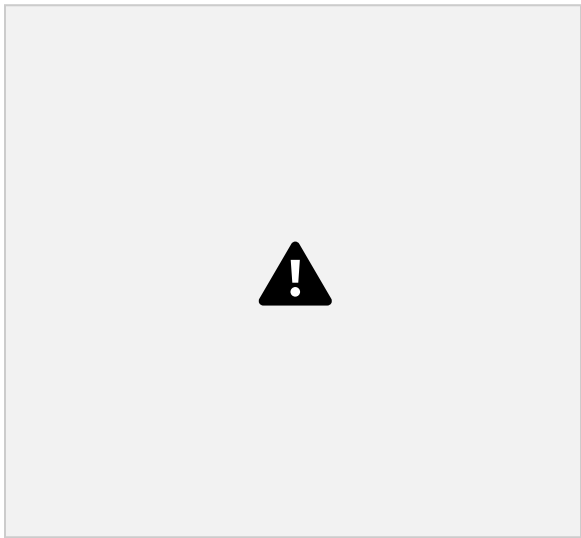
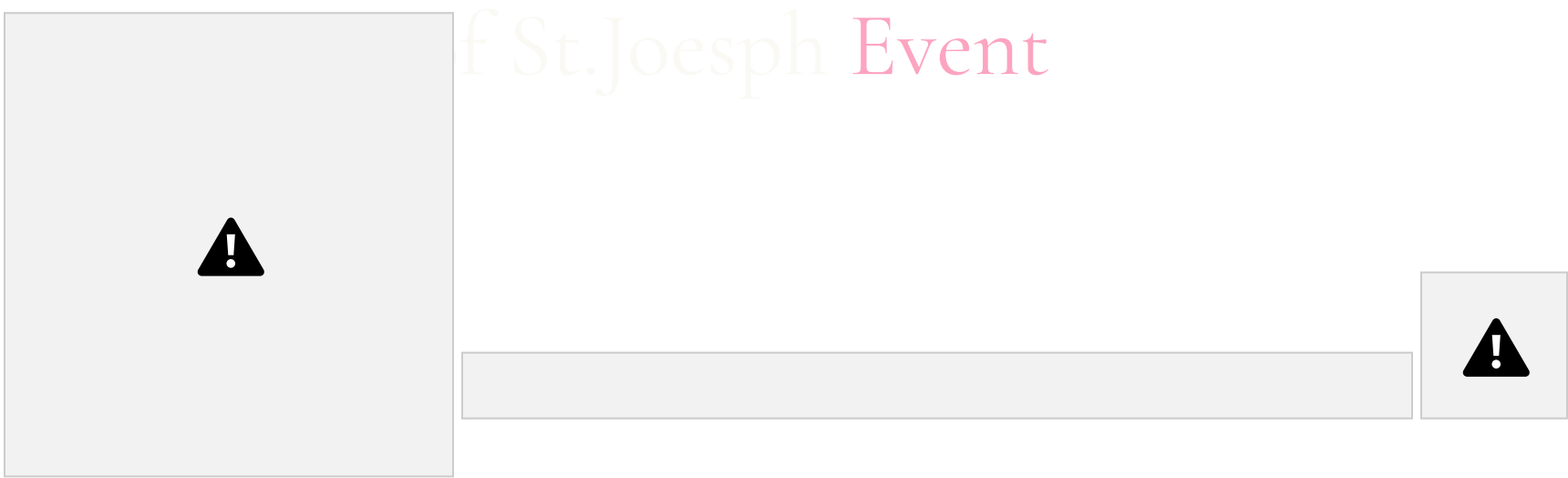
