- Books-subscriptions - what is it being spent on? Books for Harvard U detox; 10 books = \$100. RD Global mentioned there bulk order discount \$7 instead of \$10, if buying in bulk. Suggestion to buy 100 books as a cost saving. There's also book grants available through RD Global as well. One book grant previously applied for, received 20 books. Question: can each sangha apply for a book grant? Yes. Suggestion to encourage sanghas to apply.
- Question re: Intersangha 501c3 or not? Previously discussed and decided against. Should it be revisited? Is the goal to maintain and grow sanghas as we have been or do we have broader goals of providing more to the community?

- Outreach Team - Tony
 - Outreach updates: engagement/ interest in: 5 Points, Rosencrantz meeting tomorrow at 5pm (very excited!); when starting new meetings, meeting kit provided including all materials needed + books; if the meeting wants to change materials they are welcome to
 - Facilitator list - Erik has been working on updating the facilitators list for every meeting; dark green is confirmed, light green indicates airtable needs to be updated; yellow indicates changes but info needs to be confirmed; white waiting to hear back. Zach is connecting this spreadsheet with airtable database so data about changes stay updated across logs. Erik cross references this schedule to make sure listings on the RD Global website are up to date as well. Chicago area meeting rundown: 10 in person, 2 hybrid, 4 online meetings. 5 additional RD meetings in suburbs,

Aurora, Naperville, Kenosha, Madison - question to incorporate those meetings into Chicago Intersangha? Discussed outreach to those sanghas to see if they are interested in joining. Anand expressed interest in starting a new RD group in Riverside. Anand asked re: point person, meeting kit, and help finding a space. Anand asked to volunteer form on RD Chicago website; Tony and Erik will connect to help get started.

 - Sebastian and Margaret working on mentorship guidelines and mentorship matching process. Peter discussed suggestion for Mentor training so when mentors link up with sangha members, there's a playbook to help guide conversations. Discussed language nuance of sponsors, mentors; wise friends - Tony mentioned wise friends being preferable to emphasize peer relationship rather than authority
 - Intersangha social being planned - last Saturday of September hosted at Sangha House - thank you, Peter! Potluck social. Friday, Saturday Sunday there's more availability at Sangha House.

Other Business

Global Summit: Madi and Joel joined from RD GLocal; Madi, on RD Global Board, event chair; RD Summit recently occurred in Portland/online. In planning the upcoming Summit for 2025, interested in Chicago for strong sanghas/intersangha, location. Joel, lifelong events committee member involved in organizing all of the past summits.

Context: 5 in person summits, with different location year to year, each year growing bigger, Summer 2025 - July or so; Summits great

opportunity for folks across states and across sanghas to connect, learn, celebrate.

Summit programming includes RD meetings, educational workshops on topics like IFS and somatic healing, personal stories - key note, panel presentations on topics such as affinity and identity groups, social activities, break out groups on: how to start a new meeting, wise friends, inquiry groups, Expectations: partnering to figure out logistics, like space, planning programming. There's no financial commitment from the host city. Host city RD communities are encouraged and empowered to be a part of the planning process; there will be a biweekly planning meeting for the summit; it would be great to have a core team ~5 people to be involved in the planning. 10-15 people folks to help during the conference itself.

Hotel cost range - typically room rates between \$100-150; in Portland, \$113 per room, ~\$5000 for venue. Venue identified by November. Venue that can fit 200-250 people with multiple breakout rooms, at least 2-3.

Speakers: what kind of folks are we seeking? Paid/pro bono? People in recovery and involved with Buddhist practice. In the past there have been some limited paid speakers depending on the person and on budget. Speaker would be provided accommodation if traveling to Chicago. Having members of RD as speakers can be very impactful.

Detailed host city guidelines are being updated and will be sent in the coming days.

Board will meet discuss and will get back to RD Global.

RD Global board seeking to identify a host city for their next meeting on September 8.
