- Marco Evangelisti - vellum page tucked into tattered pillowcase

- Cassandra - on index card
 - As a punishment against the humans who forced her hand against her own siblings, the Fog reshaped her monsters to have a taste for humans. Whether it was flesh, soul, or blood, they would eternally feast upon the populace as a reminder of their sins.
- Phoenix Wright - soiled piece of tissue paper
 - In the century before ██████████, unrest began to brew in the human population. Records dispute the source of conflict. Some argue that the ██████████ became absorbed in their own self-importance, each considering themselves to be superior to the other ██████████. Others think that it was simply a dispute over ██████████ that escalated far beyond what was intended.
- AM - choked out of dying cult member
 - The Fog killed the Night and Day gods because they were human gods, and therefore wicked in their ways.
- Reira Akaba - stained napkin
 - With time, the Fog found herself missing ██████████. She took two of her worshipers ██████████ and entrusted them with the power of the Day and Night gods ██████████
- Soo Won [4th wall] - poorly engraved into the lid of a pewter box that once held a valuable religious artifact
 - The Fog can patch rifts, but She cannot sew them closed permanently without the aid of Her companion gods and the Gatekeeper. Losing the gatekeeper threatens to awaken ██████████ and rain calamity across the land.
- Ryou Bakura - on the back of a flyer advertising religious services

- Javert - on the back of an employee ID card for a construction worker
 - She is the Peacekeeper God. Humans failed to keep the peace, and thus, it is She who punishes mankind for their sins to restore the balance to this world.

- Atem - in a pamphlet all cultists carry on themselves
