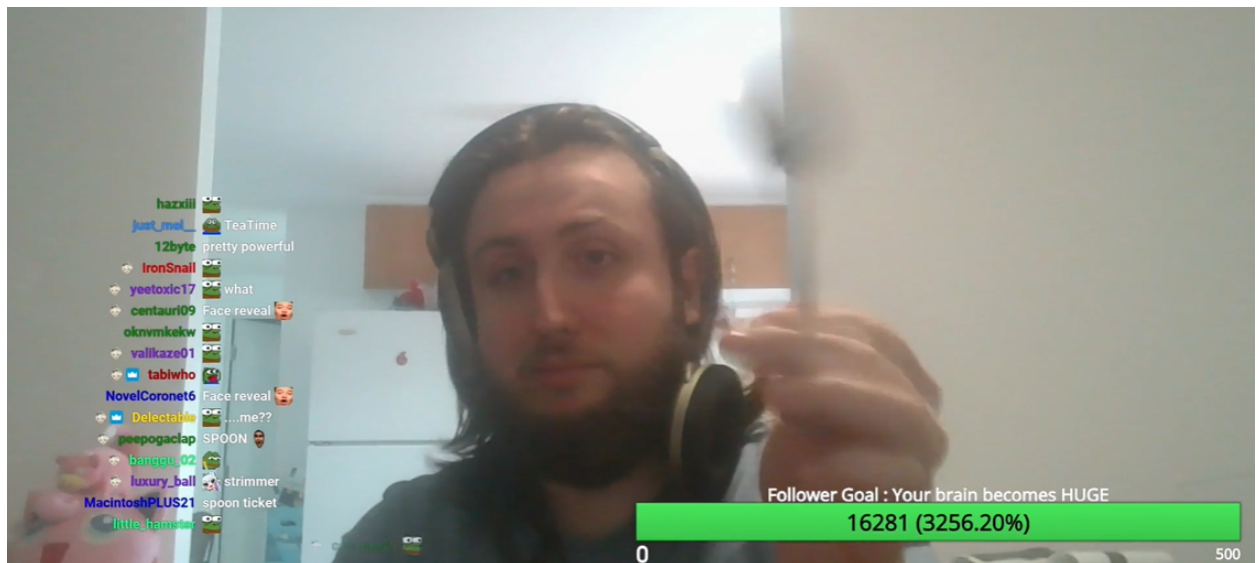

*“...Because it’s a spoon, I can swing it pretty fast, yo. [starts vibrating] mmmmm.... WOOHOO! Wow, look! I can- I can swing it incredibly fast, wow. I’ve got a really fast attack speed. Now, [starts shuffling around towards his vacuum cleaner] HERE’S A VACUUM CLEANER, alright?! This vacuum cleaner is quite a bit larger, okay? So my attack speed is gonna be quite a bit smaller. THAT BEING SAID, IF I **FUCKING** SWING THE VACUUM CLEANER –INTO YOUR FACE, YOU’RE GOING TO THE HOSPITAL!”*

The theorem above states that the “Spoon” is an entity that has “really fast attack speed” and may have less attack power than the blunt damage of a vacuum cleaner, which hypothetically would send the receiving end to a medical facility due to the fatal injuries this may cause.

“Zajef77” also proceeds to swing the “Spoon” in an incredibly fast manner, almost subsonic-like in nature. So much so, that the motion he is performing causes his vocal cords to vibrate (optional).

From this point onward, this motion will be coined as “**Zajefstriking**”.

Testing Parameters

- Both Keqing and “Spoon” have 1 minute and 30 seconds to completely destroy a construct. If the construct is destroyed after 1 minute and 30 seconds pass, it is not counted.
- “Completely eradicated/destroyed” means that the construct attacked must not be visible to the naked eye once destroyed.
- Keqing will be Level 90/90, no artifacts, and equipped with a Lvl 1/20 Dull Blade to make the playing field as level as possible.
- Keqing will be using the N4C (4 Normal Attacks followed by a Charged Attack) attack string.
- “Spoon” will be Zajefstriking throughout all tests.

Finding:

Keqing outpaces a Zajefstriking stainless-steel spoon in completely eradicating some constructs in the overworld that have “real-life counterparts”.

Evidence:

Scenario 1: A Bush

Keqing will go toe-to-toe with a Mondstadt bush located near the Teleport Waypoint. Only the one bush that is directly in front of her will be counted as the construct attacked.

Spoon will be matched with a “bush” appropriate to its size. Particular reasons, such as choosing to save my dignity by not whacking a real bush in my front garden with a spoon where all my neighbors are watching, have led to the decision to use a mock “bush”.

Keqing: Completed in under a second.

Spoon: Did not complete. Branches of the “bush” slightly bent after the test.

Scenario 2: A Pot

Keqing will go against a “slime pot” located in Stormbearer Point; these pots are accessible through the Bennett Hangout Quest in the “Ad Astra...” section.

Spoon will go against a cast iron cooking pot. This is the closest counterpart we can find in Kokomrades.

Keqing: Completed in 50 seconds.

Spoon: Did not complete.

Scenario 3: -Final Boss- The Rock(s)

Keqing will go against a set of 4 rocks located in Cape Oath.

Spoon will go against a set of 4 rocks located in my backyard.

Keqing: Completed in 14 seconds.

Spoon: Did not complete.

Significance:

We are able to identify the power level of this “Spoon” as well as Keqing’s.

The spoon is not a viable pick. 0/5 as per Tenten Rating Standard.

Use Keqing to consume your food as an alternative. Or even better, use both and have a personal Keqing spoon feed your meals.
