About Intensive Healing & Recovery Program:

It can take up to a week to obtain shelter. The program is 12 weeks long, where residents are required to attend weekly counseling sessions and classes surrounding DV education and financial literacy. Classes are typically during morning hours - must have a flexible work schedule. Participants are also required to save 35% of their income and pay the program fee of 10%. If unemployed, assistance will be given to find work. Residents can live in apartments for up to 8 months (including completion of program).
