

JOURNALS/BLOGS IN BRIGHTSPACE

Use Brightspace's Groups and Discussions tools to create journals/blogs. Journals and blogs are a great way for instructors to communicate one on one with learners in Brightspace courses. To set up journals/blogs using Brightspace Groups and Discussions use the following instructions.

Step 1 - Create Single User Group

- 1. In the Navbar click the Assessments tab then select "Groups".
- 2. Click "New Category" to create a new group.
- 3. Provide a unique category name and add a description (optional).
- 4. For **Enrollment Type**, select "Single user, member specific groups" from the drop down menu and **Restrict Enrollments** to select "No restrictions". *If you only want to journal with select learners, you would restrict to those individuals.
- 5. Click "Save".

Step 2 - Create Discussion and Link to Single User Group

- 1. In the Navbar click the Assessments tab then select "Discussions".
- 2. Click "New" then select "New Forum".
- 3. Provide a name for the forum.
- 4. Check the box for "Create a new topic in this forum with the same title".
- 5. Click "Save and Close".
- 6. Navigate to the new forum and click the drop down next to the new topic (blue text). Select "Edit Topic".
- 7. Change the Topic Type to "Group or section topic, everyone can access this topic but students only see threads from their own group or section".

- 8. A drop down menu will open entitled Group or Section Category.

 Choose the single user group created in Step 1.
- 9. Add a description or question. This is a good place to explain the expectations of the journals.
- 10. Click "Save and Close".
