All required sections of the project should be neatly placed into a report folder.

Pars Prima: Glossary

[10 points]

- Compile a vocabulary list, consisting of 15 - 20 nouns, verbs, and adjectives which appear in your passage. If it is a noun, provide the nominative, the genitive, and the gender. If a verb, the four principal parts and the conjugation. The format should resemble that of any standard Latin dictionary.
- Any and *all* proper names which appear in your passage must be glossed! Provide a brief description of each (i.e., one or two sentences should suffice).

Pars Secunda: Grammar Notes

[20 points]

- I will meet with each of you next class. During that time, I will select 10 words from your passage whose grammatical function I desire that you explain to me. If it is a noun, what is its case, and why? If it is a verb, is it subjunctive? *Et cetera*.
- The format of this section I leave up to you. Just make certain that it is neat and accurate. Some of you don't seem to grasp how grating your inability to use attractive fonts and format properly is upon my tired eyes. I pride myself on being a connoisseur of fine fonts.

Pars Tertia: Epitome of the Gallic Wars

[10 points]

- Compose a brief (1 - 2 pp DS) summary of Julius Caesar's campaigns against the Gallic tribes.
- Cite its causes, the course of the war, and how it was concluded.

Pars Quarta: Summary of Pertinent Chapter

[10 points]

- I must insist that you read, in English, the entire chapter of Caesar's *De Bello Gallico* from which your passage was drawn.
- Compose a brief (1 - 2 pp DS) of Caesar's account of the war in that chapter.
- Expect to be asked questions during our discussion on this English reading.

Pars Quinta: Helpful Map

[5 points]

- Include a *hand-drawn* color map of the key regions of ancient Gaul, and the paths of Caesar's campaigns against them.
- At least 10 locations should be clearly identified.

Pars Sexta: Summary of Pertinent Chapter

[15 points]

- Each of you will receive three short essay questions pertaining to your passage.
- Include your responses to these questions with the rest of your project.

Pars Septima: The *Disputatio*

[30 points]

- *Certamen Primum*: You must read your passage aloud, pronouncing each and every Latin word clearly and correctly. Bonus points might be in order if you are able to recite your passage from memory.
- *Certamen Secundum*: You must translate your passage into lucid English. You are NOT permitted to read from a translation you already wrote, and the only notes which you are allowed to use are those which you crafted for the sections mentioned above.
- *Certamen Tertium*: As you translate, be prepared to answer any and all grammar or vocabulary questions which I might throw at you.

DUE DATE: The project is due during the last week before Final Exams. Our discussion will take place during the week of exams. You will sign up for a specific time, and YOU WILL NOT FORGET TO SHOW UP FOR YOUR APPOINTMENT.
