

Ministry Internship Track

Who: Leaders exploring ministry who want to gain practical ministry experience.

<u>What</u>: The goal of the internship is to help the leader gain an understanding of ministry and determine whether vocational ministry is something they want to pursue further. The TCN Ministry Internship Track accomplishes this goal by combining leadership courses and hands-on ministry experience.

Where: Virtual and On-Demand with an in-person cohort time every other month at Point Church, 1503 Walnut St., Cary, NC 27511.

<u>Cost:</u> \$115 per course x 6 Courses = \$690. It is recommended that the local church cover the cost of the internship.

Length: 12 Month Commitment. Interns can begin their 12-month internship journey at any point throughout the year.
