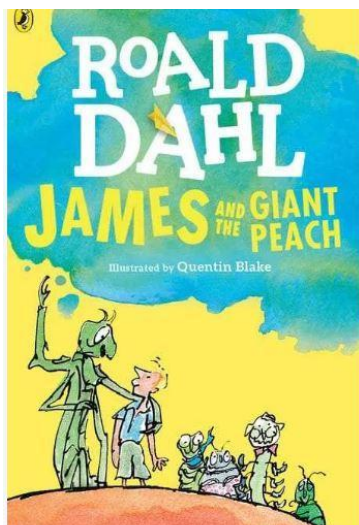




James & the Giant Peach

Did you know?... Peaches, nectarines, and apricots are part of the same plant family.



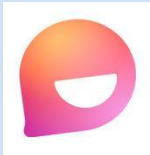

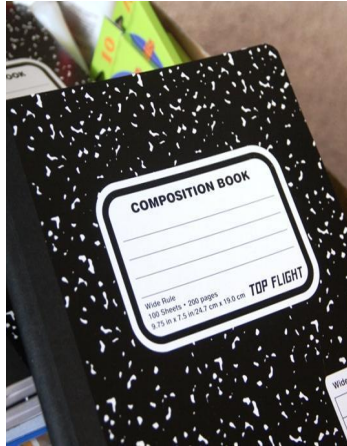
