<u>Nearpod: ELPAC Lessons 3rd - 12th</u>	ELPAC Task Types on Nearpod <ul style="list-style-type: none"> → Students (grades 3rd-12th) can practice specific ELPAC task types using the Nearpod digital platform.
<u>Data Chat Forms</u> <u>ELPAC Scale Score Ranges</u>	Data Chat Forms <ul style="list-style-type: none"> → The data chat forms are designed as a reflection piece where students view their previous ELPAC scores and write goals to work on areas of improvement. → There are three different template samples. Teachers can select the one they prefer.
<u>Effective Language Features Chart</u>	Effective Language Features (3rd-12th) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> → This chart provides effective language features such as modal auxiliary verbs, text connectives, comparative language, and more. → For grades 3-12, students should be exposed to effective language features when practicing the ELPAC speaking task types. Moreover, for the specific task of <i>Support an Opinion</i>, students must utilize an effective language feature to receive a full credit score of 3!
