Expenses; bought new checks, holiday bonuses, and gift cards for support staff, staff grants and family support, improvements for hoop house from frontier fund, OBOB books and registration, paid for nutrition services from fox trot excess, \$1700 remaining from foxtrot excess.

We may be under budget for PD - at halfway haven't spent a ton. Still haven't spent much for Friday snacks, most people don't ask for that reimbursement, Kinder meet up didn't happen so we still have budget available in that line item, Staff Grants might roll in later, but still money in that account. From family support will probably spend the rest for end of year activity fund/scholarship.

Annual Charter School Conference - next year if a PSO rep would like to attend as well, it would be a great opportunity. Usually in Nov

It was a 2 day conference and you pick sessions to attend.(2 each day)

Sessions included:

Legal update

Classroom management

Differentiation strategies

Learned about a school that bought their own building – long process (Portland Village School) It was great to hear about how different charter schools overcome challenges. Great place to collaborate and get to know people and ask questions of each other.

There was a presentation about different types of rest. Brought back to PD at the MITCH with the teachers, and talked about balancing physical, sensory, creative and other types of rest and different ways of resting. We don't often take enough time to rest. Talked about picking one type and implementing that strategy for rest. Learned about how to balance and take care of ourselves and rest more.

The best part was connecting with charter schools nearby and getting connected to their admin and being able to have that support and bounce ideas off each other. We can connect and ask budget questions etc. Camaraderie was great, and highly recommended. Consistently held down in Eugene

How many schools were there? 50% of the charter schools in Oregon were there. About 100...some are online schools.

This was the 2nd or 3rd Charter School conference since COVID

Was there a networking system in place for connecting after the event? All the slides were shared with everyone for each presentation. You kind of meet everyone on your own and make those connections. Schools are grouped together by geography.

New Business

• Staff Grant and PD Requests - Shannon

Every staff member gets \$150 grant from PSO. Also a PD \$2000 collectively (1700 left in fund.) These are typically voted on by the PSO

Teacher Helen (Ag teacher) was selected for OSU master gardener training. Training that is mostly online beginning at the end of January through OSU extension service. She is asking if the PSO could fund through PD line item. Course enrollment is \$250. Approved by MITCH admin.

Teacher Helen also requests to problem solve around muddy boots tracking in the door. There is a heavy rug coming in the side door. But not enough. Her suggestion was boot scrubbers. To potentially be located at the bottom of stairs or on the other side (back side) of the ramp out of the way. The one proposed does not need to be bolted to the ground and is a two boot at once option. A 2 pack is \$40.99 from Amazon.

Could use Frontier Garden Fund for these, there is \$1029 left in this fund before spending \$82 on the boot scrubbers

Christine says boot scrubbers work well! Holding onto the railing bar would help.

2 -4 of the scrubbers to be efficient and get the class of kids back into the school.

Does it work to keep the shoe bin by the back door? Is it possible for the kids to switch shoes there?

Request from 1st grade for books will be coming.

Fall Recap of Family Support line item in our Budget \$6500 in that budget. Meal help in Nov and Dec and also holiday gift support, coats or shoes, and usually at the end of the year we use to go to scholarship and activity fees for families in need of that help. Of the \$6500 we've spent almost \$1500 on coats (2), 6 meal gift cards in Nov, 6 for Dec, assortment of holiday gifts for families. They were distributed confidentially and a great help to our community.

STEAM Night will be January 24th from 6:30 - 8pm. Volunteers will begin arriving at 6pm along with Vendors around 5:45 - 6pm and getting set up by 6:15pm. Clean up from 8-9pm

- Youth Creative Labs robotics, art, math, and science stations
- Caesar the Therapy Llama hands on handler and will be inside the gym

We have need for volunteers for set up, line and crowd management, touch a truck supervision, and to help run some hands on science stations (same as last year with spaghetti noodle building and pennies w/ water experiments) and community art station. We'll also have clean up volunteer positions available. The volunteer sign-ups are for MITCH parents and extended family/siblings over 16. Safety and Disaster Bucket Update - Kelly

Safety bucket in every classroom, things that the teachers could grab in the case of an emergency. (bandaids, lights, toilet bags, snacks, Made Good bars (allergen free)) The bars were purchased and then recalled from Target for metal shavings. Called Made Good and in the process of working with Target to exchange those. They HAVE been pulled from the buckets. And fruit snacks are still in the buckets. At the end of the school year, all the snacks will be given out at field day, fox trot etc. so we can buy new food supply and have a fresh stock. We will see if Target will honor the original 15% off we used to purchase the Made Good bars. Thank you Kelly for dealing with the Made Good bars recall and making sure we saw the recall notice!
