School Principal's Update (IK)	Our School Principal's report can be <a href="#">accessed here</a> . Summary of the key topics below-:

- Introduced & welcomed Jessica Thompson, new CAPA teacher. Jess spoke enthusiastically about her plans for CAPA, potentially including live performances.
- New school counsellor on board. Last term only had a p/t counsellor for the whole school for the term.
- Covid settings have changed, significantly close contact rules

## Property

- Balmain campus selected as part of Metro uplift program, internet speed will increase from 1gn to 10gb. Significant benefits for performance
- Solar panel project ( aircon for cooler classrooms) is on hold waiting for a shutdown date from Ausgrid

**Action-:** IK seeking support from P&C to lobby/advocate with Ausgrid for fixture of date

## Bathroom upgrade

- Community Building Partnership Grant Phase 1 (P&C funded \$23,500), contractor has been approved. Request is awaiting approval from DoE Assets group to progress/commence.
- CG noted P&C still have funding available for another of the bathrooms. Progress is be considered in Phase 2 funding (next round of CBPG grant applications)

## Space

- Due to T centre, the school needs 2 more learning spaces/demountables. One has been approved & sourced, but with floods and installation skills in short supply, expected delivery is end of T2

## School hall

- With the size of the student population now, the school hall can no longer accommodate all 4 stages, nor is it appropriate for school functions.
- A new hall would require significant investment, > \$1m/\$1.5m. Funding would largely need to come from grant programs.
- Very early stages yet, IK has contacted DoE Assets for tender for an architecture plan.
- IK will revert to P&C to support active grant lobbying for a grant of this size.

**ACTION-:** P&C will also contact federation & other P&C to see how they have approached funding for this kind of investment, particularly where the is also a community use/benefit of the asset

## Yr10 Ski trip
