7:15-7:30 Principal's Message: Bob Huston Information and Q&A

- Feedback for conferences luncheon the teachers enjoyed luncheon, but traditionally in the evening
- 93% parent participation in conferences, 6 teachers had 100% participation
- Thank you to the School District Board for collaborative work with PTO to make the math adoption happen, we appreciate them taking a risk with so many other needs out

there.

- Library made a profit of \$3K on the book fair this year. This will go towards new books for the library.
- State report card narrowly missed an Outstanding rating
- Title1 program is off to strong start. 90 students participating
- School Site Council met on 10/26. This is a meeting to discuss school with cross-section of parents, teachers, employees, etc. Talked about:
  - School goals
  - AYP and State Report card
  - Voice levels in the building 100% buy-in from teachers, ~80% buy-in from students
  - Math Adoption Program
  - Counseling services 3 counselors, going moderately well, extreme needs are all being addressed, now working on others
  - Budget Issues 2012-2013 will be toughest budget in recent history. Not getting any more \$, there will be no improvement
  - Future Halloween protocol will continue encouraging children to bring costumes to school, but not wear all day.
  - 4<sup>th</sup> grad class sizes goal for next year is to have 3x5th grade sections
  - Future Meeting Dates:
    - Jan 18, 3:30 pm, library classroom
    - April 18, 3:30 pm, library classroom
    - Next meeting will talk about new open enrollment/interdistrict transfer law. By March, the school district needs to set limits as to how many new students it can take
  - Need to get more parents to serve on this committee
  - Each teacher will be soliciting at least one parent to from their class to participate
