#### **RIDOT Youth Bike Safety Program**

For the past 5 years, Hampden Meadows has partnered with the RIDOT to offer a 4 part bike safety training for our **5th grade students**. The lessons will take place during PE and Health classes by trained instructors the weeks of Sept 11 and Sept 18. Topics covered include: understanding the rules of the road for cyclists; the importance of wearing helmets; how to safely navigate intersections; understanding street signage; how to avoid hazards; understanding how bikes work and ensuring it is safe to ride.

Helmets are also gifted to the students but they can use their own during the sessions.

Students will practice on our hardtop with bikes provided by the DOT.



#### Recreational League Program:

The Recreational League Program allows youth who are both new to the game and experienced and are interested in learning the fundamentals, to continue to learn new skills, while participating in a fun atmosphere. This commitment is optimal for families who travel on weekends during the winter months, but whose child is still interested in playing the sport of basketball. Playing time will be equal among all players. The season will begin November 27th and end with a tournament on February 17th. Divisions in the recreational league program will be divided by grades (3/4), (5/6), (7/8). Each team will have a one hour practice during the week and a game on Saturday.

\*\*Early Bird Special \$25 OFF if register before September 15 th \*\*
Competitive Travel Program:

The Competitive Travel Program provides an opportunity for players in Grades 3-8 that have experience playing basketball, advanced skills, and are seeking an opportunity to play in a highly competitive league.

Players and families must be willing to make an increased time commitment for practice and games.

TRYOUTS are scheduled for the weeks of September 18 th and 25 th with two sessions per grade. Attendance at both tryout dates is strongly encouraged, and a third date may be offered if there are

extenuating circumstances. A tryout schedule is posted on the league website. There will be a \$40 fee to register for tryouts, if your child does not make the team, it will be refunded. The season begins the week before Thanksgiving and runs until mid-March. All teams will play in post-season tournament. Players are required to participate in 70% of Recreational League practices. An exception will be made for players on the Middle School Team. Registration for this league includes the Recreational League Fee!

Must register before September 16 th to be eligible for tryouts!
