


This fun and simple drawing game is one of my favorites.


EXPLORE:

If you can fold a piece of paper in half, while using your <u>AMAZING</u> drawing skills... this doodle game is EASY to DO!

VOCABULARY	Materials needed for this lesson:
sketch, imagination, flow	Pencil
fold, connected,	Paper
combined image	Crayons and Markers (optional)

EXPLAIN:

STEP 1 :	Take a sheet of paper.
	Fold it in half.




STEP 2: Without letting the other person see, draw half of something, like this:




STEP 3: Extend the lines slightly past the fold, and PASS the paper to the other player, with the side you extended the lines onto facing up.

STEP 4: Their job is to extend those lines into something of their own choosing, like this:

Remember NO peeking on the other side!




STEP 5: Unfold your paper to reveal your connected image.
