The set of bills seeks to ban transgender youth from participating in high school and collegiate athletic teams that align with their gender identity and ban gender-affirming health care for transgender youth. Even if approved by the Assembly and Senate, the bills would almost certainly be vetoed by Democratic Gov. Tony Evers...The trio of bills are destined to be vetoed by Gov. Evers, who met with opponents of the bill Wednesday afternoon and vowed again to reject the legislation should it reach his desk. 'I know you're here because you're pissed off and you want to stop it,' Evers said. 'And you will stop it and I'll help you stop it.'"
