

## VISIONS OF THE FUTURE: CLIMATE

### Purpose

#### Key information

**Political effects** are changes to how a place is governed or how power is shared—like new laws, rules, or leadership.

**Economic effects** impact a region or country's economy, including shifts in income, jobs, and how money and resources are used or exchanged.

**Social and/or cultural effects** shift how people live, interact, and express their beliefs—like changes in daily life, education, religion, or social roles.

**Technological effects** are related to the creation of new products or systems, such as new inventions, ways of communicating, or improvements in how work is done.
