General instructions

In this assignment, there are **two tasks**:

Task 1: You will write survey questions using the provided words.

Task 2: You will write closed-ended questions and response sets about a section of the American Sociological Association.

Task 1 instructions

Writing survey questions is fun! We just need to keep a few guidelines in mind.



Short Questions: These are concise and to the point. They are easier for respondents to understand and answer.



Long Questions: These are wordy and can be overwhelming or confusing for respondents.



Single-Barreled Questions: These ask about one specific thing. They lead to clearer answers.



Double-Barreled Questions: These ask about two or more things at once, which can confuse respondents.



Neutral Questions: These are unbiased and don't suggest a particular answer.



Leading Questions: These prompt or encourage the respondent to give a particular answer.

For the task 1, you will write survey questions using the provided words (on boxes, pages 3-4-5):

- a) Longer question shorter question
- b) Double-barreled question single-barreled question
- c) Leading question neutral question

Words can be used only once and you do not need to use all the words. The first two words of the sentences are provided. **Copy** (Command/Ctrl + C) the boxes, and **paste** (Command/Ctrl + V) below. 





- 3) Then, write one **LONGER** and one **SHORTER** closed-ended question on that topic. These questions should be the two versions of the same question. Provide the question responses, such as (1) disagree, (2) neutral, (3) agree. (10 points x 2 questions and 2.5 points for response set)
- 4) Write one **DOUBLE-BARRELED** and one **SINGLE-BARRELED** closed-ended question on that topic. These questions should be the two versions of the same question. Provide the question responses, such as (1) disagree, (2) neutral, (3) agree. **(10 points x 2 questions and 2.5 points for response set)**
- 5) Write one LEADING and one NEUTRAL closed-ended question on that topic. These questions should be the two versions of the same question. Provide the question responses, such as (1) disagree, (2) neutral, (3) agree. (10 points x 2 questions and 2.5 points for response set)
- 6) The questions should be written in line with the guideline provided in page 2.
