In the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS), Music is woven into the EYFS statutory framework through the specific area of learning called "Expressive Arts and Design".

Here's how music is implemented in EYFS:

1. Being Imaginative and Expressive

- Sing a range of well-known nursery rhymes and songs
- Perform songs, rhymes, poems and stories with others, and when appropriate – try to move in time with music
- Listen attentively, move to and talk about music, expressing their feelings and responses
- Watch and talk about dance and performance art, expressing their feelings and responses
- Sing in a group or on their own, increasingly matching the pitch and following the melody
- Explore and engage in music making and dance, performing solo or in groups
- Reception will be attending singing Collective Worship in from Autumn 2.
- Singing is also embedded into their routines throughout the school day.
