## PA FCCLA SPIRIT OF ADVISING AWARD

**PURPOSE**—To recognize chapter advisers who are constantly faithful, often quietly working behind the scenes to ensure the success of their students. They usually go above and beyond normal adviser practices.

**ELIGIBILITY**--Every state is eligible to submit one adviser for the National Spirit of Advising Award. Nominations must be made by state adviser/state facilitator/ other FCCLA advisers. Advisers who have received this award within the last five years are not eligible.

**SUBMISSION PROCEDURE**--Complete the nomination form, and return with three letters supporting the nomination to the state office. Letters should be from other professionals. Follow submission directions on the Adult Award Applications opening page. **Deadline is January 15**.

Upon receipt of the nomination form, a personal data form will be sent to the person submitting the nomination. It needs to be completed and returned to the state office.
