Criteria for entry into a Special Programme

Criteria for enrolment on to the special program will be given to the following groups of students

- *Students who live within the enrolment zone whose parents/aiga have expressed a desire for their child to learn in a Samoan bilingual learning environment, a willingness to play an integral part in their child's learning journey and work in partnership with the school.*
- *Students enrolling from the onsite Aoga Amata – Faavae Motu Aoga Amata*
- *Children who are the siblings of current or former students*
- *Students who have proven Aiga (family) links to the school*
- *Students enrolling from a previous Samoan bilingual programme*

Priority for enrolment

The priority groups for acceptance into the programme are as follows:

- *First Priority – Students enrolling from the onsite Aoga Amata – Faavae Motu Aoga Amata*
- *Second Priority – Students who are siblings of current or former students of the bilingual programme*
- *Third Priority – Students who have proven Aiga (family) links to the school*
- *Fourth Priority – Students who are enrolling from a previous Samoan bilingual experience*
- *If there are more applicants than places in a priority group, places will be allocated by ballot*

Process for enrolment

Students will apply for a place on the programme and will be accepted based on the priority groups described above.
