As a Global Ambassador, I understand that I will do the following:

- > Copy my Regional Director (RD) when replying to student emails.
- > Reply within 5 business days or less to prospective student emails
  - I will contact my RD if this is not feasible.
- > Fill out the Global Ambassador Activity Completion Form after each activity (event, social media post, website review, etc.),
- > Collect contact information from prospective students at any event I host (if allowed) and send these details to my RD.
  - o I will also make note of how many materials (brochures, pens, etc.) were used.
- > Abide by all campus policies when representing Semester at Sea.
- > Abide by Semester at Sea Social Media Guide and Campus Social Media Guidelines
- Communicate regularly with my Semester at Sea RD.
- ➤ Remain in good standing with Semester at Sea; demonstrate professionalism, collegiality, and a spirit of collaboration--in actions and in written and verbal communications --when representing Semester at Sea.
- > Allow my contact information (a SAS-provided GA email address) to be posted on the SAS website and social media for future participants that wish to be connected with an alumnus/a.
