

SPNA Meeting Minutes 12/11/2023

The SPNA monthly meeting was held at the McCabe Community Center. The meeting was called to order and a quorum was recognized. President, Jenny Komoll, presided.

Minutes: Minutes from the November SPNA meeting were accepted with no changes.

REPORTS OF PROGRAMS AND COMMITTEES:

Membership: 158 members; thirty-four have signed up for 2024 so far.

Treasurer:

- Income: \$2,500 above plan.
- **Motion:** Pay printing bill of \$1,379.07; **motion seconded and passed.**

- A request was submitted for an apartment complex at 39th-40th and Charlotte. Council woman Gadd is holding meetings on December 11th and 16th at the W. Precinct Bld and will hold a virtual meeting in January. This was deferred at the December meeting in order to get additional community input.

- Pole lighting on the roundabout looks great.
- Soliciting artists for the Sylvan Park Sign; one submission so far.
- Mural on Murphy Rd underpass: reached out to CSX consultant; trying to get \$1,000 fee waived. We can likely get approved, and some artists are interested. There will be money available through the Civic Design Center in January; we will need to apply for it.

- Emergency contact magnets will be available at the January SPNA meeting.
- Community donations and nominations: a note went out on November 13th to solicit donations and nominations; and reminders continue to go out. Police and Fire platters will be delivered on December 18th.

New Business:

- McCabe Little League will have a speaker next year. Registration closes on January 8th.
- Anthony Cooper submitted a request to get the lights fixed around the parking area at the McCabe Community Center parking lot. Others can also go to Hub.Nashville.gov and submit a request. Jenny will get the numbers from the poles that are out and submit a request.
