

WWI/WWII/Holocaust History

Grade Level: 11th -12th

Prerequisite: U.S. History or U.S. History Concurrent

This is an advanced history course that focuses on the events surrounding World War I, World War II and the Holocaust. Students should have an understanding of U.S. and World history before enrolling in the course. Students should be highly motivated and willing to be an active participant in class. Primary source documents and college level readings are used throughout the course to give students a clearer picture of the major events that took place in the years 1914-1945.
