- Start small! Pick a topic and it is ok if you can only meet once a year.
- Get to know each other and make friends!
- Be patient about the growth of your pod
- We are all volunteers! So work on this when you have time, if you don't, that is ok!

- To start, the main goal is to just get the members together
- Social media is a great tool to grow your pod.
- You can use the Request a Scientist database to recruit members for your pod
- First meeting can be casual, just get together and talk about your passions
- After some meetings, ask help from other members for organizing meetings

- When planning meetings, make them accessible to everyone
- Contact your regional coordinator
- Successful events are usually the ones where parents can bring their kids
- Remember to also have private events just for the pod members

- Best ways to get people to attend:
 - Vary day, time, and location of meetings
- In our website there are ideas for different events and partnerships for pods, including:
 - Skype a scientist
 - Letter to a scientist
 - Work with local museums
 - Season festivals/carnivals
- What platforms to use to communicate within the pods
 - Google groups (very private!) is probably the best option
 - Slack
 - Facebook groups

- St Louis reached out to local Universities and offered help with mock interviews, reviewing CVs. They also worked with local stations to talk about science and 500WS
- Use Google Sites to create a pod website (It's free!). In the pod shared drive there are some templates available.
- We ask for non-work emails due to privacy issues
- Reach out to alumni organizations to invite people to your pod!
