CATS 'N' BRIEFS - Terms of Service

Cats 'n' Briefs is a collaboration between 2 artists: Eddie (aka cedamuc1) and Oiruse.

We're combining our strengths to create all kinds of digital art! Anything we can think of: from simple doodles, to full fledged traditional animation, creating all kinds of cute, funny, and sexual scenarios involving cute critters and the like!

A. Contacting Us For A

Commission

- a. <u>Private Message vía Twitter</u> You can private message us and we'll get back to you about our status.
- b. Private Message vía Patreon If you're a patron of ours you're more than welcome to DM us an inquiry about whether or not we're open either. You're also free to suggest ideas for us to draw if you're not interested in a commission either.

Once we have messaged you back regarding the commission, we'll send you a commission form to fill out and once we approve of that, we can get started.:)

Please be aware that our DMs are open for inquiries only. We only want questions related to commission work and things you're unsure about, not personal life stuff.

Any client who decides to share an excessive amount of unnecessary extra details about themselves or their life, roleplay, share pictures or videos or stories unrelated to the task at hand (the commission) MAY BE AT HIGH RISK OF BEING IGNORED AND/OR BLOCKED. AND ANY COMMISSION IN PROGRESS CANCELLED!

We apologize in advance for any inconveniences, but if anybody is offended or upset by this. But we are here to WORK, not to chat.

We will also generally announce when we are open, but do not be intimidated if we aren't. We don't mind if you ask us whether or not we're open because sometimes we are but rather not announce it publicly since we're a bit shy. Asking never hurts too <3

By also commissioning us, you agree to our TOS.

B. Commission Slots

We work by opening and filling a list or queue with slots. If the slots are filled and you are not in the list, you will have to wait and try again the next time we open a new batch of slots.

We will prioritize clients that did not get a chance to fill a slot in the previous batch. My aim is to give a chance to as many people as possible.

That said, clients added to the queue slots, as well as their order and priority may be changed or removed at OUR DISCRETION ONLY.

C. Basic Rules

First of all, you MUST be an ADULT (+18). If so, and our commission status is OPEN, fill up the form with your request following the rules.

We will let you know if a spot is available for you or not as soon as possible.

If it's already full, please wait patiently for next time. My aim is to make sure everyone gets a chance.

By talking to us about a commission, you are confirming you're over the legal age in your country and have read and are complying with our terms.

Also, please do not message us with the intention of free art. We're working hard to do our best and we plan on doing raffles in the future to give back to those who are helping us. It's hard to do stuff for free when we're still working on surviving on our own. Please respect that.

D. Guidelines On How to Request

If you're on the queue list, once it's your turn, we will notify you through a reply on your DM or Note, to let you know we can start work on your commission.

Make sure to write down *EVERYTHING* related to the commission in the form. We'll ask you questions based on it when we start work a bit before clarifying anything we're confused about but otherwise, we will follow your response as closely as possible.

We will message you and tell you about whether or not we can work on the commission, and if everything is all good on both ends, we'll tell you a price and once it's paid upfront, we'll get to work ASAP.

Please do not change your idea once we have told you we have started work on it. If you request time-consuming edits and changes, we will charge you extra based on how much work we have done up to that point.

WE WILL NOT DO ANY WORK ON THE COMMISSION UNTIL IT HAS BEEN PAID.

Once the money is received, we will start work on the requested piece.

We will send you updates on the piece as we are working on it, so make sure to stay alert for updates, and let us know as soon as possible of any mistakes to fix or edits necessary. The sooner we spot a mistake to fix, the better. It's harder to edit things on a finished piece, and it may cost you extra.

If requested, we may be able to work on your piece while STREAMING. This will most likely be done through Discord unless the commissioner favors another platform that we can use like Picarto or Piczel. This is recommended since it helps bang out the commission quickly and very little mistakes during the drawing process since you can spot them as soon as they appear!

E. Pricing and Payment

Our full price sheet can be found here.

ALL COMMISSION PAYMENTS WILL BE DONE UPFRONT. No matter what kind of commission you want it's all done upfront once we finish settling on a price for your request.

Payment is only accepted through PayPal, done through EUROS (€).

Please only send the payments through as a gift (family & friends), if possible.

PRICES MENTIONED ARE "STARTING AT", meaning they MAY VARY depending on the size, detail and complexity of the characters and backgrounds requested in the picture.

If the character(s) or background requested are excessively detailed, we will charge extra for the picture (and you have the right to refuse the payment and request altogether if you disagree). For example:

- Full Body Character: A naked black kitten will be CHEAPER than a fully-armored, spotted character.
- Backgrounds: A simple box or single table will be CHEAPER than a book-filled library

F. Themes (What we will draw)

> Things that we are *fine* with drawing (things highlighted in green means we like it a lot!):

- Furry / anthropomorphic animal characters.
- Feral Animals / Creatures.
- Almost any kind of proportions/style: Natural, Toony, Abstract...
- Most Carnivore/Omnivore mammals. (Canines, Felines, Mustelids, Ursines...)
- Original Characters: Characters specifically "made within the furry community".

- Long, Coily things such as tentacles, long tails, snakes too!
- Original Character Creation / Design / Reference sheets.
- Comedy / Exaggeration / Parody.
- Happy / Chill / Calm / Romantic / Tender
 Moments. "Slice of life".
- Size Difference.
- ANY anatomy: Thin/Slim, to Buffy, Fat or even Obese Characters.
- Cartoon Physics.
- Messy Fluids and Liquids: Drool, Cum, Pre, Goo...
- Bad ends / Catastrophic situations / "Game Over" scenes...
- Fatal fate / Death. (Implied or not, and Skeletons / Remains)
- GAY Sexual activities of any kind: Anal Sex, Blowjobs, Rims...
- Incest Scenarios...
- Hypnotizing / Drunk / Drugging / Mental Manipulation / Domination.
- Vorarephilia / Vore of any kind: Anal, Cock, Oral, etc. (Oiruse LOVES this <3)
- Body Manipulation or Abuse: Squeezing / Constricting / Stretching...
- Transformation (Eddie loves this :3), Morphing and/or Mutation, Melting...

- Character interaction
- > Things that we are **NOT fine** with drawing:
 - Scat or Watersports (no pee or poo)
 - Diapers.
 - Babyfurs or children in Sexual, Adult or Mature situations.
 - Political, religious themed subjects, celebrities and any racist or purposefully offensive material.
- > Things that you should ASK us about drawing:
 - Humans / humanoids.
 - Female Characters (we CAN draw them as well as Shemale and Trans, but they will prioritize Male characters).
 - Copyrighted characters. BEWARE. We are VERY PICKY with who we will accept drawing.
 - (for example, WILL draw: Hanna-Barbera Characters, Warner Bros. Characters, Most Cereal Mascots, Most Videogame characters and Pokemon...)
 - (for example, we will NOT draw: Characters from the Sonic the Hedgehog series, My Little Pony series, Rick and Morty, Family Guy, the Simpsons, Garfield series...)

- If you have any doubts, please ask. We apologize in advance if we decline your request, and any inconveniences.
- Overly detailed, complicated and visually complex characters, creatures, machines or objects.
- Guro/Gore, blood and physical torture, abuse or pain.
- Animals or mythical creatures that are not within the range of "Carnivore or Omnivore mammals".

Depending on the theme or circumstances of the request, or our mood, we may accept to draw certain themes that we usually wouldn't agree to draw.

➤ Example 1: We won't do violence, but we may accept to draw it if it's "toony", or lighthearted.

Feel free to ask us further about this, but don't expect or assume that we will accept such requests.

We have the right to decline a commission request if we feel the need to, either because of the theme of the request, or for personal circumstances, and only at our discretion.

G. Clear Request Descriptions

While describing your request, BE CLEAR. Make sure you KNOW what you'd like to request before you fill out the form.

It is strongly advised that you share or send reference pictures and examples in the commission form. This helps us immensely to get a clear idea of exactly what you want.

We can draw characters out of text descriptions though. If you only use text, please share as MUCH detail as possible.

We don't mind reading through so much text! We just want to make sure we capture your vision in our minds to.:)

H. Canceling a Commission

If a client decides to cancel their request before We have started work on it, they will be removed from the list without penalty.

If the request has already been paid, and there has been NO WORK or progress made on the piece, the money will be refunded.

BEWARE: If the request has already been paid, and work has already begun on the piece, the money will be returned to the client in proportion to the amount of work made for the piece requested.

I. Failure to Behave and Blacklist

First of all, please be RESPECTFUL to fellow clients and people around you during chats, comments on a piece, replies on twitter, etc. Remember that not everyone likes everything and that's okay.

If you have any problems or issues, please let me know as soon as possible so we can do our best to solve them through peaceful means.

Basically, NO HATE SPEECH ALLOWED.

Clients who start or cause any kind of harassment or offense to me, any of my other clients, any of our friends, or anyone who does not deserve it, no matter the reason, will be removed from the queue or list, We will refuse to work with them, and any commissions in progress will be CANCELED!!

BEWARE: You may also be BLACKLISTED and BLOCKED. We refuse to do business with people who do not behave or are not polite with us or others.

J. Final Fixes and Details

Once we consider the piece finished, we will send the finished piece to you.

During the final reviews, the requester still has a chance to ask for small edits and fixes to the final piece. However, besides small fixes, once a picture is considered complete, and/or follows the description initially agreed upon by both parties, we will refuse any further work on it unless the requester agrees to pay for any extra work on the piece/pieces.

K. Upgrading Commission Picture

Prices on the table DO NOT Stack up.

What this means is that if, for example, you were to request a picture to be a full character sketch, the price to pay would be the one where it says so.

But if you like the picture enough to refine its lineart, or add color and/or shading to it, instead of pricing it again as it is on the table, it is possible to upgrade it by only adding the rest of the work paid individually.

This also counts for the preview pictures. The price of the

preview picture is NOT a separate price. It will be included in the final piece.

L. Posting Publicly and Crediting

Once both the payment and picture are considered fully complete by both client and artist, We will send the client a full resolution version of the picture.

Additionally, we will be using the commission for promotional material unless stated otherwise. We have the right to not post or post the commission work, unless it is private in which case it's completely yours to use however you like.

WARNING: A private commission will incur a **15% fee** on top of the original price.

If you decide to post your piece in your gallery, or elsewhere, please credit <u>our Twitter account</u> as stated before. That's all <3

M. Recommendations For a Commission

Our recommendations:

- Pixel Sketches are great If you want something quick yet still detailed and don't mind the resolution or monochrome art (B&W). (they are also my favourite way of drawing)
- We highly recommend adding a background. Believe it or not, it adds a LOT to a picture or scene.

- Don't be afraid to suggest working in different ways for different parts of a single picture or animation.
 Sometimes blurring a background rather than having it be detailed, or turning a character to be a silhouette may help the piece a lot, and will cost you less!
- For animation, keep in mind that the prices are merely a rough estimate. If you would still like one but are unsure if you can afford it, lowering the framerate can still work and will be more affordable, to the point of even possibly halving the price!
