Griesbach Regatta Results - Saturday, August 2nd, 2025

The Griesbach Regatta honors the Griesbach family and their gift of the Rhodes 19 to the Club. There is a brief description of the family's harrowing escape from Germany during the Second World War on our website.

We had a nice sunny day of sailing with winds in the 4-8 range with periods of calm, which was much better than the published forecast of light and variable winds. It is worth noting that light winds give the smaller boats an inherent advantage, highlighting the limitations of handicap ratings.

The races were very tight when adjusted for the handicap. We had a total of three races. The first two races were windward-leeward courses. The final race was a port triangle.

Florian Schroeck skippered his FJ to a first place finish with crew member Bill Fontaine. Second place went to Gary Orkney and Nancy Dennis in a Rhodes 19, who had a first place finish in the second race. **Third place** was tie-breaker captured by Donna Bowie & Randy Dickson in an O'Day Daysailer with two third place finishes. Fourth place went to Dave & Paul Beaufait and Valerie Stinson in the Griesbach Rhodes 19. They tied for third place in terms of points, but Donna & Randy had better finish places that broke the tie. Cathy Geiger and Hans Mueller finished in fifth place with sixteen points in their Sidewinder, edging out the sixth place finish in a tie-breaker. They missed the first race, which put a big dent in their results, but they had a strong fourth place finish followed by a first place finish. Sixth place was snagged by the Cookie Monster, a Rhodes 19 skippered by Reed Bergwall with crew member Gabbie Black. They also had sixteen points and a best finish of fourth in the first race. In seventh place overall. Kerry deWolf pulled off a third place finish in the last race by threading the needle during a mark rounding, sailing with Chris Doyle and Paul Tobias in the Mariner 19. Philip & Cameron Glouchevitch finished in eighth place in their Daysailer with a sixth place finish and two sevenths. George Pennacchi took ninth place in his Precision 18. Finishing in tenth place was John Brady, Rod & Amber in the Club's O'Day Daysailer. It's likely that the centerboard did not go the whole way down for some reason, as they would have ruled the waves if it had!
