Introduction

The Muslim Students Association of the US & Canada – also known as MSA National – is an umbrella organization that supports and represents Muslim students in their Muslim Students Associations (MSAs) in high schools, colleges, universities, and professional schools in the United States and Canada.

MSA National was established in 1963 at the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign by students and is one of the oldest Muslim organizations in North America.

Mission

MSA National seeks the pleasure of Allah (SWT) by empowering Muslim students with resources aimed at fostering character and leadership development (tarbiyyah), campus activism and da'wah, and connecting for a unified vision.

Vision

MSA National envisions a unifying movement, rooted in deen, of all Muslim Student Associations, cultivating safe and transformative spaces for all Muslims on campus and continuing to serve the Ummah beyond graduation.

Affiliation Period

Affiliation with MSA National runs on an academic term basis. Affiliation for 2024 will run from **January 1, 2024, to July 1, 2024**. After this period, the affiliation period will restart and MSAs must renew their affiliation with MSA National. More information will be provided by May 15, 2024.

Terms & Agreement

Affiliation and Opt-Out Policy

All Muslim Student Associations are considered affiliated with MSA National upon completion of the Chapter Affiliation form at the start of each academic year (June - August). A

non-refundable affiliation fee of \$20 is recommended, but chapters can still complete full affiliation if payment is not possible.
