World History I Syllabus

The rules for this class are as follows. I don't use a seating chart – students are allowed to sit where they choose in class. That said, if students begin to talk during instruction/lecture and cause distractions or disturbances in the class, then I will move them and reserve the right to implement a seating chart if needed. There is to be **NO CELL PHONE OR HEADPHONE USE**. Students who break this rule will be sent to the office immediately.

The Course

World History I will focus on the beginning of human history to the year 1500. Students will be expected to participate in daily discussions, journals, and lectures as well as study and be prepared for quizzes and tests. For the most part, work will be done in class, and assignments not finished during class will become homework that night.

Grading

Tests(Gold Assignments): 40%

Quizzes(Silver Assignments): 35%

Participation/Homework/Classwork(Bronze Assignments): 25%

School-Based Late Work Plan

- It is the student's responsibility to communicate with the teacher **in writing** about the plan for submitting late work.
- Late work will be accepted up to 3 calendar days after the due date. If that date falls on the weekend/breaks/student absence, students should communicate with the teacher on submission requirements.
- No assignment will be accepted beyond three days of the original due date.
- Late work will be accepted at a penalty of 25% off of the earned grade.
 - **Late work formula calculation**→ **Student Score x 0.75 = Final Assignment Score**
 - *ie. if a student submits an assignment late and earns a 90, the late penalty would be 22.5 points deducted for a total of 67.5% grade*
- *Additional penalties may apply to IB diploma programme courses.*
