**This tradition was about loosing forever...at the beggining only women practised it and in some cases, fighting against the opini3n of some men who thought that work was nonsense and not important at all. But women here were brave and they knew that they should fight for it, they made a rebellion y and the very important major of the place gave them an official permisi3n to continue working on this ART.**

**Thanks to the tenacity and strenght of these women BONECOS were recognized as WORLDWIDE INMATERIAL HERITAGE by UNESCO.**
