SLT Meeting Minutes February 27, 2025 4:30 – 6:00pm

Minutes approved for January 23, 2025

Updates:

- **CEP** is mostly on track, not quite making progress in math. Next meeting we can discuss the goals for next year (without the end of year data). Once data is available, adjustments can be made.
- **i-ready** Admin team met with i-ready. Not yet where we would like to be, but students show significant progress. Reading 40% of students are on grade level, Math 35% are on grade level.
- **After-School Programs:** Curriculum has been strategically planned with money allocated for specific groups (temporary housing, ELL's, etc.). One of the considerations is assisting ELL students that have plateaued (expanding for more than 2 years) to foster more academic growth. Due to the pendulum shift of reading, there is more phonics-based instruction but less organic independent reading time built in. Keeping this in mind we want to ensure a well-rounded reading experience for all. For 4th and 5th grade students that are slightly below or at risk of slipping back (2.9 3.1) there is curriculum to support them and guide them forward.
- In School Programs: Targeting regular small groups of students in the classroom with specific interventions that meet their needs (phonics, vocabulary, comprehension etc.).
- In the Arts: Black History Month included Violin Performance
- ELL Audit with the district went well and will be returning to look at instruction.
- PA Meeting 2/25 had a large turnout with 73 participants.




SLT Activity for Parents and Teachers: In groups we discussed and charted thoughts in response to the three questions and shared our thinking.

What are the core beliefs of PS/IS206 when it comes to education?







What do we want our students to be able to know and do by the time they graduate?
