AGENDA ITEMS:

1. Open House with the Population Analysis Committee (PAC) at Granger High School on March 20th. at 7:00 pm. All SCC members are invited. Did anyone not get an invite? It was sent a week ago.
2. RISE Preparations this year. All core departments have planned/calendared a RISE Training Test, a RISE Benchmark, and explicit teaching of test taking strategies. We are working very hard to prep the teachers and the students to get them ready for the test, and test taking strategies.
3. Utah Jazz Fitness program- April 12th at 9:00 am. Students track (papers passed out earlier this month) exercise, food and water intake, the top earners win prizes. (swag, tickets) the Jazz bear and Jazz dancers will be here.
4. Enrollment projection- 560 for 2024-2025. This is our best guess.
5. 2024-2025 LAND Trust Estimated Distribution- **\$82,825**, not counting minimal carry-over from 2023-2024 (we can only carry over 10%)
 - Goals, action steps, and budgets for 2024-2025

Proposed Goal: RISE Growth: On the 2025 RISE Assessments, school proficiency will increase 3% compared to 2024.

For ELA, proficiency on the 2025 RISE will increase by 3% to 20% schoolwide.

For Math, proficiency on the 2025 RISE will increase by 3% to 19.1% schoolwide.

For Science, proficiency on the 2025 RISE will increase by 3% to 24.4% schoolwide.

Action Step and Expenditure: LAND Trust funds will pay for two teachers (0.5 FTE each, 1.0 FTE total) to allow for the additional sections of core classes.
