## **Competitor Responsibilities**

Participants shall:

- Obey instructions from the Event Organisers, Commissaires and event marshals/officials.
- Employ correct etiquette and ride safely in all situations.
- Be required to wear minimum safety gear including an appropriately approved helmet.
- Ensure that their bicycle is in good working order.
- Ensure they have adequate supply of water, sports drink and nutrition as required for the activity they are to participate in.
- Be responsible for ensuring they are fit enough for the activity.

Please note that all U15 and U17 riders must be entered by Wednesday, 22<sup>nd</sup> October. This is essential to ensure the allocation of appropriate Grades for racing per the AusCycling junior policy.

Presentations will be conducted at the Lilydale Football Club - Doah Rd



All place getters must be present at Football Club for Medal presentation.

#### **Race Numbers**

Riders will be issued with grade number. Fitted to the lower back.

Numbers must not be cut, folded or modified in any way. Numbers must be returned or a fine will be issued.



#### First Aid / Medical

Professional medical services will be qualified First Aid volunteers, who will be available on circuit and will be directed by Chief Com.

The nearest hospital is the Launceston General Hospital.

### **Technical Regulations**

The event will be conducted under the rules and regulations of AusCycling (AC) and the Union Cycliste Internationale (UCI). The AC & UCI scale of penalties will apply. ### Type of Event

Handicap Road Race - Silver level

#### **State Grade Championships**

As there will be no spares car following - riders who have mechanical or other issues will not be given assistance by following car or persons involved in race. Coaches or mechanics can attend the rider but no help to get rider back to grade or be given a lap out.

If a rider needs assistance there will be a Sag Wagon patrolling the circuit and Riders are encouraged to have their phones with them if they need assistance.

There will be First Aid on the circuit and all assistance needed will be given.

Note: Juniors Riding Up Policy will be applied allowing u15 riders to race in an appropriate grade on age restricted gearing.

\*Special NOTE Riders are NOT to stop or congregate at finish line, riders must return to Lilydale Football Club. No Cars are allowed near Finish unless involved in Race

#### **Venue & Course Details**

Riders marshalled at Football Club grades leave together under neutral control until Dewhurst Rd and race will start when all riders are present.

Race will continue along River Road C811 turning left at River Road and Bangor Road junction C811 continue to Karoola Road C823 then left into Lalla Road C822. Continue on towards Lilydale Road where Marshal's will control intersection as this is downhill into Give Way section on Lilydale Road B81. Riders then will be under control through Lilydale town centre.

Riders will be asked not to attack in this zone for safety reasons and Commissaires will police this zone.

Riders will ride in anti-clockwise around the circuit:

- A grade 5 Laps
- B grade 4 Laps
- C/D Grade 3 laps
- E/F 2 laps

Lap length is 16.5 km
